GENERAL FLAG COLOR MEANINGS:

Red or Pink represents feminine characteristics

Blue represents masculine characteristics

Purple represents a combination of both masculine and feminine characteristics

Green represents the non-binary spectrum because it is the inverse of purple (a combination of both red and blue, which are used to represent feminine and masculine)

Yellow represents the non-binary spectrum and the spectrum between the masculine and feminine

Gray or Grey represents semi- or half way point

Black or White represents all, none, or neutral

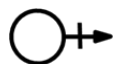

GENDER IDENTITIES:

Absorgender / Absorbgender – An individual who absorbs the genders of the people around them. As one is around more people, more genders are added to the genders one feels. These genders remain until one reaches a "maximum", at which point they become a blank slate, and revert to a single "base" gender. This base gender can be any gender and can be different each time it is reached.



Adversgender – An individual whose gender is connected to Satanism/Luciferianism, rebellion, freethought, defiance of social expectations and norms, and has an intense feeling, be it dark or otherwise.



Aeregender – An individual who doesn't know what their gender is, but has a vague idea. These are subgenders:

- **Aeremin** – An Aeregender that is masculine in nature
- **Aerefin** – An Aeregender that is feminine in nature
- **Aerenin** – An Aeregender that is non-binary in nature
- **Aerelin** – An Aeregender that is between or fluid between masculine or feminine
- **Aeragin** – An Aeregender that is agender in nature
- **Aerezen** – An Aeregender that is xenine in nature



Aerogender – An individual whose gender changes based on the setting or atmosphere the individual in. This can refer to things like temperature, weather, time of day, time of year, elevation, level of comfort, emotions, or who they're around. Aerogender can be used as an umbrella term or as a specific gender.



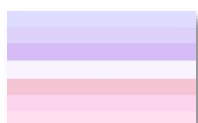
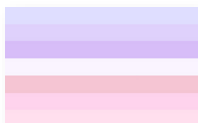
Aesthetigender / Aesthetgender / Aesthetegender / Videgender – An individual whose gender experience is derived from, or the embodiment of, an aesthetic (or other set of visuals or sensory experience). As a non-binary identity based on concepts other than female or male, it is in the category of xenogender.



Aesthetifluid – An individual whose gender is fluid depending on their current aesthetic of interest.



Aesthetiflux – An individual whose gender fluctuates in intensity of feeling or fluctuates between aesthetigenders.

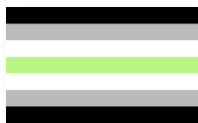


Aetherium / Calliegender – An individual who feels disconnected from binary womanhood but possesses an essence of femininity in a celestial, ethereal, or otherworldly way, regardless of assigned gender.

AFAB – Acronym for “Assigned Female at Birth based on external primary sex characteristics. Aka DFAB “Designated Female at Birth” and CAFAB “Coercively Assigned Female at Birth”.

AMAB – Acronym for “Assigned Male at Birth based on external primary sex characteristics. Aka DMAB “Designated Male at Birth” and CAMAB “Coercively Assigned Male at Birth”.

AGASI – Acronym for Alternative Gender and Sexual Identity



Agender / Genderless / Gender Apathetic – An individual who feels gender neutral, gendervoid, non-gendered, or does not identify with any gender.



Agenderfluid / Cancegender – A genderfluid individual who is mainly agender but can experience fluctuating or fluid feelings of gender correlating with one's emotions.



Agenderflux / Librafluid / Libraflux – An individual who feels mostly agender, which then can fluctuate to other genders.



Agori – An individual whose agoraphobia affects one's gender.



Agregender – An individual who is influenced or affected by one's experiences of age regression to a younger state of mind. Age regression in psychotherapy that facilitates access to childhood memories, thoughts, and feelings.



Aliengender / Aliegender – An individual whose interpretation of their gender feels as if it is from a non-human perspective. The term could also be a kingender and a similar term would be externusgender.



Amascuafluid – An individual who is mostly agender but also masculine and occasionally but rarely has genderfluid traits. The feminine counterpart is Afemmafluid.



Androgxne – An individual whose gender is both androgynous/androgynous and agender/genderless in some way. Someone who identifies as Androgxne could be Multigender, Agender, or fluctuating between Androgynous/Androgynous and Agender/Genderless.



Androgynous – An individual that has both male and female gender characteristics or identifies as being between male and female.



Androgynous – An adjective describing an appearance that is in between male or female and may not necessarily be associated to the person's identity.



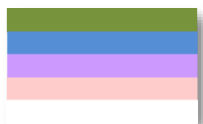
Aporagender – An individual who has a non-binary gender separate from man, woman, or anything in between, while still having a strong and specific gendered feeling. This identity could be considered the Western cultural version of 3rd Gender.



Apxrine – An individual whose gender is both aporine (entirely separate from masculine, feminine, androgynous descriptors) and agender/genderless in some way.



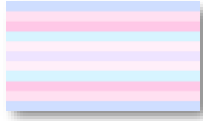
Aroace Agender / AAA / Triple A / AAA-Spec / A – An individual who identifies with all 3 spectrums or "aro" (for aromantic spectrum), "ace" (for asexual spectrum), and "agender" (for agender spectrum).



Arogender – An individual whose identity is influenced by being on the Aromantic Spectrum or their Aromantic Spectrum identity influences their gender in a significant way.



Audiogender – An individual that more actively becomes a gender based on the more they hear about a certain gender or an individual that based their gender identity on sound or music. Terms included under the umbrella of Audiogender include: Cadensgender, Demicadens, Genderjukebox, Genderplaylist, Guitargender, Jazzian, Musicagender, Turcallegra, Ampligender, Boomgender, Carmigender, Impediogender, Mufflegender, Phonogender, Vocagender, Voicegender, and Voluflux.



Babycoric – An individual whose gender identity involves the imagery of pastel, cute, and childlike objects and aesthetics. They can have any gender expression. Similar genders include Childgender, Sanriocoric, and Sanriogender.

Beyondsexual – An individual in a plural system who feels as if they are beyond human interpretations of sexuality, or that their sexuality cannot be described. A system is a collection of multiple entities sharing one body due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Bigender – An individual who experiences 2 genders. The genders may be any combination and those genders can be binary or non-binary. They may be experienced simultaneously or may alternate. They may or may not be experienced equally.

Birth Assigned Sex – The anatomical sex as determined by biology or genetics. Not all babies are born with genitalia that can be clearly defined as either male or female. And not all babies develop a gender identity that matches their birth assigned sex.



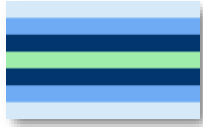
Blurisysgender – An individual that feels blurred or hard to recognize due to blurring of alters in a system. This identity is exclusive to traumagenic systems. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Boi / Boy – A lesbian or gender-queer individual who identifies mostly with their male energy and presents as male in their appearance.



Borderix – An individual whose identity feels stronger when the individual has a favorite person (FP) and feels almost nonexistent when without one. This identity is exclusive to Borderline Personality Disorder (BPD).



Boyflux / Manflux – An individual who has an identity that fluctuates between being a boy, a demiboy, genderless, and various degrees of intensity in-between.



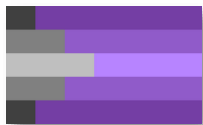
Boyish – An umbrella term for any male-aligned, man-aligned, boy-aligned, masculine-aligned gender, or feeling close to a boy. It is an alternative label for Mingender, Mascgender, and Miaspec. The feminine version is Girlish.



Butch – A individual's gender expression matches their culture's understanding of masculinity and masculine roles. Butch originally referred to a gender role of masculine lesbians but its usage is no longer exclusive to lesbians. It is on a spectrum that goes from butch to femme. An individual who is a soft butch presents closer to neutrality than extreme masculinity.



Bxy – An individual whose gender is both male and Agender/Genderless in some way. They could be Multigender, Agender, or fluctuating between feeling male and agender/genderless.



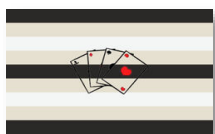
Caedogender / Caedgender – An individual whose gender has been cut away by a traumatic event or gender that has been damaged or lost due to trauma. The term can be combined with others such as caedogirl, caedoboy, caedononbinary, etc. This term is exclusive to trauma survivors.

Card Deck System – A gender system that relates to cards. Cardgender alignments can be used to refer to one gender, two genders, or a demigender.

Main Terms

- **Cardgender** – A gender related in some way to cards or a single type of card in a deck.
- **Democardgender** – A gender that is partially related in some way to cards or a single type of card in a deck, and partially another gender.
- **Cardfluid** – Someone who is fluid between cardgenders.
- **Panocardgender** – Someone who identifies as all cardgenders or feels as if their gender is related to a whole deck of cards.
- **Multicardgender** – Someone who identifies as more than one cardgender.

Cardgender Sets

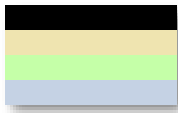
- **Diamondcardgender** – A gender related to the diamond cards.
- **Spadecardgender** – A gender related to the spade cards.
- **Heartcardgender** – A gender related to the heart cards.
- **Clubcardgender** – A gender related to the club cards.

Cardgender Values

- **Acecardgender** – A gender related to the ace cards.
- **Kingcardgender** – A gender related to the king cards.
- **Queencardgender** – A gender related to the queen cards.
- **Jackcardgender** – A gender related to the jack cards.
- **Numbercardgender** – A gender related to a specific number on a card.

Cardgender Alignments

- **Cardmasculine** – A gender related to a cards, that is also masculine.
- **Cardfeminine** – A gender related to a cards, that is also feminine.
- **Cardnonbinary** – A gender related to a cards, that is also non-binary and/or abinary.
- **Cardneutral** – A gender related to a cards, that is also neutral.
- **Cardoutherine** – A gender related to a cards, that is also outhetine.



Cassgender / Cass – An individual who feels that their gender identity is not important or irrelevant to them.



Casspronoun / Apapronoun – An individual who does not have preferred pronouns and is indifferent towards what pronouns people use for them.



Celestial Gender System – A group of non-binary xenogenders that have a connection to space/celestial energy.



Ceterogender – An individual who literally “feels other genders.” It is a Non-binary gender identity with particular masculine, feminine, or neutral feelings.



Childgender – An individual whose gender feels childlike, or like children, specifically those who have not reached adolescence or puberty. This term can be used in age regression, littles in systems, and neurodivergent people. Similar genders include Genderfluff and Littlefluid.



Cisgender – An individual whose gender identity and gender role matches their birth assigned sex i.e. a non-transgender individual. They fit well into the binary gender system. *Cis* is Latin for “on the same side” or “on this side of”.

Colorgender – An individual whose identity relates to any color in some way. Labels under this umbrella include:

- **Albagender / Valgeian** – A gender that relates to the color white.
- **Alexandridic** – A gender that fluctuates in color and presentation depending on outside conditions.
- **Aquagender** – A gender that relates to the color aqua.
- **Beltzaain** – A gender that relates to the color black.
- **Blaunauc** – A gender that relates to the color blue, indigo, and aqua.
- **Blushgender** – A gender that relates to the color blush.
- **Boqorgeerigender / Purgender / Purplegender** – A gender that relates to the color purple.



- **Bluegender** – A gender that relates to the color blue
- **Bubblegumgender / Bubgumgender** – A gender that relates to the color bubblegum pink.
- **Caerulgender / Violagender** – A gender that relates to the ocean and the sky at the same time.
- **Chromaergender** – An individual’s colorgender changes with the colors, shades, and/or hues of the season, the environment, who they are with, or other external factors.
- **Chromafluid** – An individual who identifies with all the colors in the world (aka the color chart).

- **Chromagender** – An individual who relates to the colors of a flag.
- **Citruslusia / Orangegender** – A gender that relates to the color orange.
- **Colorgender** – A gender that relates to one or more colors and the feelings, hues, emotions, and/or objects associated with that color.
- **Colorqueer** – An individual who associates their gender/orientation with all the colors of the rainbow and they might change depending on how they feel.
- **Coolcoloren** – A gender that relates to cool/cold colors (blues, purples, etc.)
- **Darkcoloren** – A gender that relates to dark colors.
- **Darkgender** – A gender that relates to the absence of color or dark colors/shades.
- **Faicheian / Greengender** – A gender that relates to the color green.
- **Femnoire / Neoion** – A gender that relates to neon colors.
- **Fluorogender** – A gender that relates to fluorescent colors.
- **Fuchsiac** – A gender that relates to the colors of fuchsias.
- **Fuchsianix** – A gender that relates to the color fuchsia.
- **Fýsian** – A gender that relates to soft nature colors.
- **Genderblank** – An individual whose gender is indescribable so it is a blank space.
- **Gendercolorare** – An individual whose identity feels like it has been tanned by some outside force to become a different gender.
- **Genderpastel** – A gender that feels pastel, soft, gentle, and quiet.
- **Gendertabernis** – An individual whose identity contains many different colorful genders that all work together as one major gender.
- **Glitchofluid** – An individual who is fluid between genders that are related to glitch and eyestrain colors.
- **Gloender** – A gender that moves between either darkness and light, or slightly dark to more dark.
- **Gradient Gender** – A gender that is vague and feels like a point on a gradient where any given point could be a gender and can be vaguely identified but never pinpointed at an exact/precise color.
- **Grattiaen** – A that relates to the color gray.
- **Grayscalen** – A gender that relates to grayscale colors (white, grays, and black).
- **Hotpinkgender** – A gender that relates to the color hot pink.
- **Kafean** – A gender that relates to the color brown.
- **Koraalaic** – A gender that relates to the color orange, coral, yellow, and gold.
- **Lightgender** – A gender that is described by the presence of all colors at once.
- **Lilagender** – A gender that relates to the color lilac.
- **Luridgender** –: a gender that has a connection to pastel colors, but also a dark mind.
- **Maronic** – A gender that relates to the color maroon or crimson.
- **Neongender** – A colorful gender that shines brightly, and can be distracting.
- **Oeilsangine** – A gender that relates to eyebleed colors.
- **Palettegenger** – An individual whose identity creates a palette of multiple colors and the feelings associated with them.
- **Pastelgreengender** – A gender that relates to the color pastel green.
- **Pasugosgender** – A gender that relates to both pastel and goth.
- **Pastelgender** – A gender that relates to light, pastel colors.
- **Pearlescegender** – A gender that relates to pearlescent colors.

- **Periwinklian / Periwinkleyn** – A gender that relates to the color periwinkle.

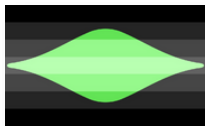
Genderpink / Roseatine – A gender that relates to the color pink.

- **Prismagender** – A gender that relates to all colors of the rainbow.
- **Rainbowgender** – A gender that relates to the rainbow.
- **Redgender / Rosuine** – A gender that relates to the color red.
- **Rosagender** – A gender that relates to the color rose.
- **Ruusuoan** – A gender that relates to the color rose, pink, and magenta.
- **Solisgender / Yellowgender** – A gender that relates to the color yellow.



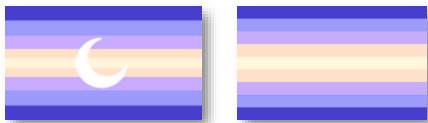
- **Tealgender** – A gender that relates to the color teal.
- **Technigender** – A gender that can be described by multiple, but not all colors.
- **Temnovezgender** – A gender that feels dark, but not absent.
- **Tonegender** – A gender that fluctuates between two colors on a gradient or wavy scale.
- **Vërgender** – A gender that relates to warm, airy, and associated with sun and bright and/or lighter colors.
- **Warmcoloren** – A gender that relates to warm colors (pinks, oranges, etc.)

Confugender – An individual who knows they are fluid or fluctuates between genders but doesn't know what gender they are at a certain time.



Corugender / Flashgender – An individual whose gender is affected by their PTSD or other conditions that cause flashbacks. Some individuals use this term to express how their gender is affected by past lives.

Crossdresser / Transvestite – An individual that likes to dress and spend part time in the gender role that is opposite the birth assigned gender. These individuals do not desire to change their birth assigned gender. Transvestite is the obsolete term.



Cuddlegender – An individual whose gender identity focuses on the love and security one feels around their stuffed toys.



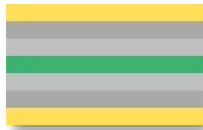
Demiboy / Demiman / Demimale / Demiguy /

Demidude / Demibloke – An individual who partially, but not wholly, identifies as a man, boy or otherwise masculine, whatever their assigned gender at birth. They may or may not identify as another gender in addition to feeling partially a boy or man. Demiguy can describe someone assigned male at birth who feels barely connected or disconnected to that identification. Demiguy can also describe someone assigned female at birth who is transmasculine but not wholly binary-identified, so that they feel more strongly associated with male than female but not strongly enough to want to identify as a man. Demiguys may also identify as demigender, non-binary and/or transgender. The counterparts are Demigirl, Deminonbinary, Demineutrois, and Demianders.



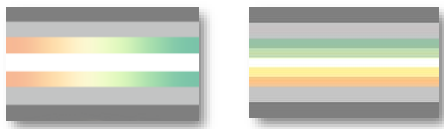
Demifae – An individual whose gender identity is partially

static and partially fluid (Demifluid). The fluid part of the gender is only fluid between identities which are not male, male-aligned, or masculine. The static part of the gender can be any gender or combination of genders.



Demifaun – An individual whose gender identity is partially static and

partially fluid (Demifluid). The fluid part of the gender is only fluid between identities which are not female, female-aligned, or feminine. The static part of the gender can be any gender or combination of genders.



Demiflor – An individual whose fluid part of the gender

identity fluctuates between identities which are not male, male-aligned, masculine, female, female-aligned, or feminine. The static part of the gender is undefined, and can be anything.



Demifluid – An individual whose gender

identity is partially fluid and partly static. The static part of the gender can be any gender or combination of genders. Demifluid people may also identify as non-binary, genderfluid, and/or transgender. Identities under this umbrella include:



- **Demifluid Androgyne** – An individual whose static part of their gender Androgyne or generally Liaspec. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



- **Demifluid Boy** – An individual whose static part of their gender is a boy, boy-related, or generally Miaspec. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



- **Demifluid Girl** – An individual whose static part of their gender is a girl, girl-related, or generally Fiaspec. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



- **Demifluid Non-Binary** – An individual whose static part of their gender is Non-Binary. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



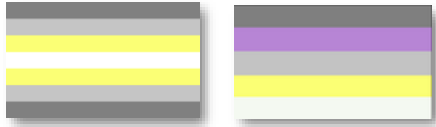
- **Demifluid Outherine** – An individual whose static part of their gender is an Outherine gender like Aporagender, or generally Aiaspec. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



- **Demifluid Xenic** – An individual whose static part of their gender is one or more Xenogenders, a Xenic gender, or generally Xiaspec. The fluid part of their gender can be between any genders.



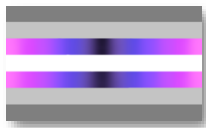
- **Demiflux** – An individual whose gender identity is partly static and the other part(s) fluctuate in intensity.



Demigender – Demigender is an umbrella term for non-binary gender identities that feel a partial, but not full, connection to a particular gender. Demigender identities include, but are not limited to: Demiboy, Demifluid, Demiflux, or Demigirl.



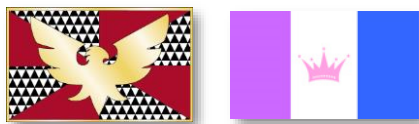
Demigirl / Demiwoman / Demifemale / Demigal / Demidudette – An individual who partially, but not wholly, identifies as a woman, girl or otherwise feminine, whatever their assigned gender at birth. They may or may not identify as another gender in addition to feeling partially a girl or woman. The other part of one's gender can be any gender or combination of genders. The counterparts are Demiboy, Deminonbinary, Demineutrois, and Demiagenders.



Demisylphen – An individual whose gender is partially static and partially Gendersylphen.



Disemotugender – An individual whose gender changes while experiencing an emotion or feeling associated with their disorder(s). The emotion or feeling could be dissociation, instability, depression, paranoia, or anxiety, etc. This can be due to a specific disorder or a symptom of an unknown one. This term is an umbrella term in the Muto-Disordered Gender System.



Drag / Feather / Crossdresser – An individual that dresses in clothing opposite their birth assigned sex.

Drag King – A masculine female presenting as a male.

Drag Queen – A feminine male presenting as a female.



Elmogender – An individual whose gender identity is connected to the character Elmo from Sesame Street.



Episogender – An individual whose gender changes while they are in an episode related to a disorder such as Borderline Personality Disorder (BPD), Intermittent Explosive Disorder (IED), Schizophrenia, or other disorders. This identity is exclusive to individuals with disorders involving episodes or outbursts.



Etorgender – An individual whose identity is always or almost always present but becomes much stronger when age regressed. This term is for system littles/age-sliders and non-kink age regressors only.

Eunuch – A male who has been castrated.



Exogender / Pseudogender – An individual whose gender is affected by their pseudomemories or exomemories. This identity is under the Exomyn umbrella specific to those in plural systems of Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Faeian / Doeian / Thilian – A multigender individual who does not experience male or masculine genders. They can experience feminine genders, unaligned genders, neutral genders, genderlessness, etc. but never any masculine or male genders.



Faerian – A multigender individual who does not experience male genders. They can experience feminine genders, unaligned genders, neutral genders, genderlessness and masculine genders but never any wholly male genders.



Faunflux – An individual whose gender fluctuates in intensity but never feels feminine or female.



Faunian / Fawnian – A multigender individual who does not experience female or feminine genders. They can experience masculine genders, unaligned genders, neutral genders, genderlessness, etc. but never any feminine or female genders.

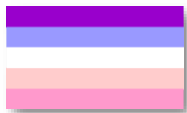


Femboy / Tomgirl / Calicogirl – An individual who is gender non-conforming, Mingender, and Miaspec who present femininely in some way.

Feminine / Femininity – A set of behaviors, presentations, and roles which are culturally associated with being a woman and/or possessing female sex characteristics. Individuals of any gender identity or sexual orientation can be feminine, as femininity is not designated by biological sex or gender. The concept of feminine is based on socio-cultural settings.



Femme – An individual, usually gay, bi, lesbian, or queer, who exhibits stereotypical feminine traits in an exaggerated way. This may be done for various reasons such as reclaiming, embracing, or subverting concepts of femininity. Hard femme is an edgy or hard-rock expression of femininity. High femme is an extreme expression of femininity.



Fiagender Spectrum / Fiaspec – An individual who is on the female side of the gender spectrum which includes female, partly female, female-aligned, female-adjacent, female-related, or femaleness.



Frestanofem – A feminine-aligned individual who is connected to strawberries, bananas, strawberry-banana flavored yogurt, strawberry cows, childhood, and nostalgia. Its counterpart is Frestanoxen.

Fish – An individual that is defined as a black feminine lesbian. It is meant to be an identity that is exclusively used by black people and sometimes for feminine Latinx lesbians.



Gaigender – An individual whose identity is aligned with, or totally connected to, Mother Earth. Their identity is a way to acknowledge that they are a part of her, inseparable from her, and honor her.



Galactian Alignment System / Galactian Alignments – A gender system created for non-binary individuals to describe their gender without using binary concepts of masculine or feminine aligned identities.

Galactian Genders:

- **Aurorian:** Fluid between alignments
- **Lunarian:** Feminine aligned
- **Solarian:** Masculine aligned
- **Singularian:** Rejecting all ties to any alignment
- **Stellarian:** Neutral aligned or unaligned
- **Spacialian:** Xenine-aligned

Combination Alignments:

- **Annulian:** Spacialian, Stellarian, and Solarian
- **Eclipsian:** Lunarian and Solarian
- **Galaxian:** Lunarian, Solarian, and Stellarian
- **Meteorian:** Spacialian, Solarian, and Lunarian
- **Nebularian:** Lunarian and Stellarian
- **Novarian:** Solarian and Stellarian
- **Penumbrian:** Spacialian, Stellarian, and Lunarian
- **Phoenixian:** Spacialian and Stellarian
- **Siderealian:** Spacialian, Lunarian, Solarian, and Stellarian
- **Universian:** Spacialian, Lunarian, Solarian, Stellarian, and Singularian
- **Cometian:** Spacialian and Lunarian
- **Pistolian:** Spacialian and Solarian

- **Celestian:** Partly Stellarian
- **Constellian:** Partly Galaxian

Gender Binary – A gender identity structure that allows for only two genders, usually the traditional male and female.

Gender Free – An individual that does not identify with the accepted definitions and standards of binary gender structures.



Gender Fluid / Gender Flexible – An individual whose gender identity moves and has no set gender.



Gastrohoarder / Gastrocollector – An individual who collects gastrogenders. The terms under this umbrella include:

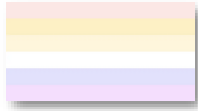
- **Drinkshoarder / Drinkscollector** – An individual who collects drink genders
- **Fasthoarder / Fastcollector** – An individual who collects fast food genders
- **Fruithoarder / Fruitcollector** – An individual who collects fruit genders
- **Savhoarder / Savcollector** – An individual who collects savory genders
- **Sweetshoarder / Sweetscollector** – An individual who collects genders related to sweet things like candy, cakes and confectionary. Identities include: Angelmilkgender, Cakegender, Candyic, Glazegender.
- **Teahoarder / Teacollector** – An individual who collects tea related genders



Genderbeyond – An individual who feels as if they are beyond gender or that their gender cannot be described because they are a non-human species without gender identity or with an identity that cannot be interpreted by humans. This identity is exclusive to systems due

to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.

Gender Binary – The gender binary system is based on the idea that there are only 2 possible genders, a biologically created man and woman based on their genitalia. An individual that identifies as a gender outside of this binary are called Non-Binary.

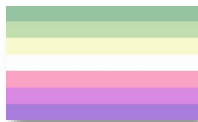


Genderblankie – An individual who feels like they are covered in a warm fuzzy blanket that makes them feel super small, and happy. This identity is exclusive to age regressors



Gender Creative / Gender Expansive – An individual whose conception of their gender differs from the prevailing social norms. In particular, it is commonly used for when a child or teenager rejects gender norms and stereotypical expression, commonly seen in children who are raised without a prescribed gender (known as "gender creative parenting").

Gender Diversity – A spectrum of gender identities which encompasses far more than the two choices of the binary system.

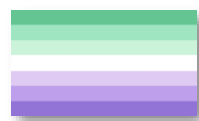
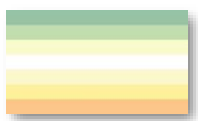


Genderdoe / Genderfae / Genderthil – A genderfluid individual that never encompasses male or masculine genders. They can be fluid between any range of feminine, genderless, unaligned, or neutral gender. The masculine complement is Genderfaun. Variants include Genderfaer, in which they can experience all genders but a binary man, and Genderselkie, where the non-binary genders experienced are often Xenic.



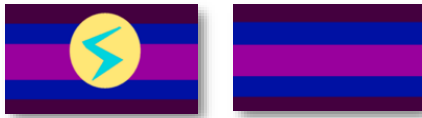
Genderfaun / Genderfawn – A genderfluid individual that never encompasses being female or having feminine genders. They can be fluid between any range of masculine, genderless, unaligned, or neutral gender. The feminine version is Genderdoe. Variants include Genderfaunet, in which they can experience all genders but a binary woman, and Gendersatyr, where non-binary genders experienced are often Xenic.

Genderflicker – An individual whose identity switches on and off rapidly.



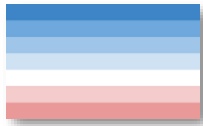
Genderflor / Wyvegender – A genderfluid individual who is fluid between any range of non-binary genders, unaligned genders

genderlessness however, they are never a binary man or woman and do not experience genders that are related to masculinity or femininity. Related identities are: Genderfloren, Genderflorent, Genderflorer, and Genderfloredden.



Wyvegenger

Genderfloren – A genderfluid individual whose identity encompasses everything except being a binary man or woman.



Genderflorent / Genderflorentflux – A genderfluid individual whose identity encompasses everything except being feminine, or a binary man. An individual that is Genderflorentflux feels that their gender varies in intensity but stays within the boundaries of what Genderflorent describes.

Genderflorer – A genderfluid individual whose identity encompasses everything except being feminine, or a binary man.

Genderfloredden – A genderfluid individual whose identity encompasses everything except being masculine, or a binary woman.



Genderfloredden – A genderfluid individual whose identity encompasses partial masculinity and femininity up to, but not including, being a binary woman.

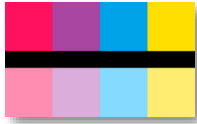


Genderfluff / Fluffgender – An individual is an identity that makes them feel warm and fuzzy inside and it could also be an attachment to pastel femininity as well as fluffiness. This label was created for age regressors but can definitely be used by anyone.

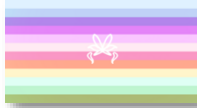


Gender Fluid / Gender Flexible – An individual whose gender changes over time. They can identify as any gender, or combination of genders. Their gender can change at random or it may vary in response to different circumstances. The earliest known definition appears in Kate Bornstein's book *Gender Outlaw: On Men, Women and the Rest of Us*, which defines genderfluidity as the "ability to freely and knowingly become one of many of a limitless number of genders, for any length of time, at any rate of change. Gender

fluidity recognizes no borders or rules of gender.” Identities under this umbrella include: Genderfae, Genderfaun, Genderflor, and Genderfluidflux.



Genderfluidflux / Fluidflux – An individual with an identity that is a combination of Genderfluid and Genderflux. It is both fluid in what gender it is, as well as fluctuating in intensity.



Genderfluid Fragment Gender System – A group of fluid gender identities that cover fluid genders that are not fluid through part of the gender spectrum, but not all of it. The system also provides more specific fluid genders. The identities are:

Genderlyph Root

- **Genderlyph** – Genderfluidity that specifically encompasses Xenine or otherwise rare genders.
- **Genderselkie** – Genderfae that specifically encompasses feminine and Xenine genders but no masculine genders.
- **Gendersylphet** – Genderflorete that specifically encompasses feminine and Xenine genders but no masculine genders, while never being a binary woman.
- **Genderselkier** – Genderfaer that specifically encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders, while never being a binary male.
- **Gendersatyr** – Genderfaun that specifically encompasses masculine and Xenine genders but no feminine genders.
- **Gendersylpher** – Genderflorer that specifically encompasses masculine and Xenine genders but no feminine genders, or binary man.
- **Gendersatyret** – Genderfaunet that encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders while never being a binary woman.
- **Gendersylphen** – Genderflorete that encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders while never being a binary man or woman.

Genderdoe Root

- **Genderdoe** – Genderfluid that never encompasses masculine genders.
- **Genderfaer** – Genderdoe that specifically encompasses everything except being a binary man.

Genderfaun Root

- **Genderfaun** – Genderfluid that never encompasses feminine genders.
- **Genderfaunet** – Genderfaun that specifically encompasses everything except being a binary woman.

Genderflor Root

- **Genderflor** – Genderfluid that never encompasses masculine or feminine genders.

- **Genderflore** – Genderflor that encompasses everything except being masculine or a binary woman.
- **Genderfloreten** – Genderflore that encompasses partial masculinity and femininity up to, but not including, being a binary woman.
- **Genderflorer** – Genderflor that encompasses everything except being feminine or a binary man.
- **Genderflorent** – Genderflorer that encompasses partial femininity and masculinity up to, but not including, being a binary man.
- **Genderfloren** – Genderflor that encompasses everything except being a binary man or woman.

Genderfruct Root

- **Genderfruct** – Genderfluid that specifically encompasses masculine, feminine, and non-binary genders.
- **Genderfrict** – Genderfruct where femininity is amplified.
- **Genderfrect** – Genderfruct where masculinity is amplified.
- **Genderfroct** – Genderfruct where unaligned identities are amplified.
- **Genderspirit** – Genderfruct but specifically fo Xenogenders.

Genderfrith Root

- **Genderfrith** – Genderfluid that specifically encompasses genders which are masculine and/or feminine.
- **Genderfrithet** – Genderfrith that encompasses all masculine and/or feminine genders except being a binary woman.
- **Genderfrither** – Genderfrith that encompasses all masculine and/or feminine genders except being a binary man.
- **Genderfrithen** – Genderfrith that encompasses all masculine and/or feminine genders except being a binary man or woman.

Gendersylph Root

- **Gendersylph** – Genderfluid or Genderflor that specifically encompasses Xenine or otherwise rare genders.
- **Gendersylphet** – Genderflore that specifically encompasses feminine and Xenine genders and no masculine genders, while never being a binary woman.
- **Genderselkie** – Genderfae that specifically encompasses feminine and Xenine genders and no masculine genders.
- **Genderselkier** – Genderfaer that encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders while never being a binary male.
- **Gendersylpher** – Genderflorer that specifically encompasses masculine and Xenine genders but no feminine genders, or binary man.
- **Gendersatyr** – Genderfaun that specifically encompasses masculine and Xenine genders but no feminine genders.
- **Gendersatyret** – Genderfaunet that encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders while never being a binary woman.
- **Gendersylphen** – Genderfloren that encompasses feminine, masculine, and Xenine genders while never being a binary man or woman.

Gendersaros Root

- **Gendersaros** – Genderfluid that experiences genders to be androgynous in some way.

Genderflick Root

- **Genderflick** – Genderflor that specifically encompasses genderless genders.
- **Genderflicket** – Genderflorete that but specifically encompasses genderless and feminine genders.
- **Genderflicker** – Genderflorer that specifically encompasses genderless and masculine genders.
- **Genderflickeur** – Gender fluid that specifically encompasses genderless, masculine genders and can be binary man.
- **Genderflicke** – Genderflor that specifically encompasses neutral, non-binary, and genderless genders.
- **Genderflickex** – Genderflor that specifically encompasses xenic and genderless genders.
- **Genderflicken** – Genderflorete that specifically encompasses neutral, feminine, masculine, and genderless genders.

Genderkirin Root

- **Genderkirin** – Genderfae and/or Genderselkie but femininity is amplified.
- **Genderkilen** – Genderfae and/or Genderselkie but Outherinity is amplified.
- **Genderqilin** – Genderfae and/or Genderselkie but Xeninity is amplified.
- **Genderkylan** – Genderfae and/or Genderselkie but Agenrinie is amplified.
- **Genderkeilun** – Genderfae and/or Genderselkie but neutrality is amplified.

Gendergilen Root

- **Gendergilen** – Genderfaun and/or Gendersatyr but masculinity is amplified.

Genderfirn Root

- **Genderfirn** – Genderfaer and/or Genderselkier but femininity is amplified.
- **Gendermirn** – Genderfaer and/or Genderselkier but masculinity is amplified.
- **Gendernirn** – Genderfaer and/or Genderselkier but neutrality/non-binary genders are amplified.
- **Genderlirn** – Genderfaer and/or Genderselkier but Androgynity is amplified.
- **Genderxirn** – Genderfaer and/or Genderselkier but Xeninity is amplified.

Genderfyun Root

- **Genderfyun** – Genderfluid that never encompasses either binary or non-binary genders.

Genderund Root

- **Genderund** – Genderfae where the genders involved are confusing or difficult to describe.

Gendergryph Root

- **Gendergryph** – Genderfaun where the genders involved are confusing or difficult to describe.

Genderflir Root

- **Genderflir** – Genderfluid that is primarily female or feminine, but can encompass all genders.

Genderfloy Root

- **Genderfloy** – Genderfluid that is primarily male or masculine, but can encompass all genders.

Genderflight Root

- **Genderflight** – Gender which is always changing, but always connected to nature.



Genderflux – An individual whose identity changes in intensity. Both genderfluid and genderflux individuals have feelings of gender that can change over time. The following are a few examples: Agenderflux, Girlflux, Boyflux, and Fluidflux.

Genderpunk

Genderfuck / Genderpunk – An individual whose gendered expectations are deliberately played with to combine gender-specific signals. The term is closely associated with drag culture. Drag performers may or may not identify as genderfucks. The act of engaging in this identity is sometimes referred to as genderfucking.

Gender Identity – The way in which an individual expresses their gender. Sex is the biological classification of male or female. Gender is associated with the mental body and sex is associated with the physical body.



Gender Neutral – An individual with a gender identity that is neutral, neither male nor female, but genderless, i.e. agender. Gender neutral pronouns include the singular they/them/theirs and a gender neutral title is Mx.



GenderNH – An individual whose gender identity is impacted by being nonhuman in some way. This includes, but is not limited to, alterhumans and nonhumans in systems, delusional misidentification, vampires, and any alterhuman.



Gender Nihilist – An individual who believes in getting rid of gender in society altogether so that people can live free of misogyny, transmisogyny, and heterosexism. Gender nihilism does not restrict people's expressions but these expressions would no longer be gendered traits.



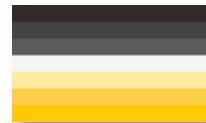
Gender Non-binary – A gender identity structure that embraces a spectrum of genders rather than just male and female.



Genderqueer – An individual whose identity is other than traditional male or female, some combination of both male and female, queers gender in some way, or subverts gender expectations.



Gender Religeic – An individual whose gender has been affected negatively by their current or previous religion. This term is exclusive to those who are/were practicing a religion at some point in their life.



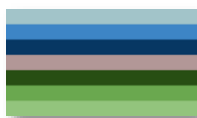
Gendersafe / Gendersafeflux – An individual whose gender becomes more intense when near or interacting with someone they feel safe around/have built trust with. This identity was created for trauma survivors and those who struggle to feel safe but can be used by anybody who shares this experience. **Gendersafefluid** is an individual whose gender changes when they are near or interacting with someone they feel safe around/have built trust with.



Genderselkie – An individual whose gender is fluid between all genders except for masculine or male genders. The term is similar to Genderfae but specifically includes Xenogenders. The masculine counterpart is Gendersatyr.



Gendersource – An individual whose gender does not align with their source's gender identity, yet still feels connected to it, and may feel like they are/are supposed to be that gender despite not identifying as such. This identity is exclusive to individuals who are Introjects, Fictives, or Factives and that have a system such as Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.

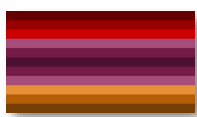


Gender-Sporadic – An individual whose gender changes but does not follow a specific pattern and feels sporadic.



Gendersylphen / Genderfaonen / Genderfeoren /

Genderfenen – An individual whose gender is fluid, either exclusively or near-exclusively, between Xenogenders or more uncommon masculine/feminine gender identities. Subcategories under this identity include: Demisylphen and Pangendersylphen.



Genderunstable – An individual whose instability affects their gender or feel that their gender changes when they are mentally unstable.

Gendervague – An autistic individual who may have an unconventional understanding of gender. This term can be used similarly or interchangeably with Neurogender or sometimes Autigender.



Gender Variant – An individual's behavior or gender expression does not match the "normal" gender roles set by society for males and females. This term can be synonymous with Genderqueer, Non-binary, and Gender Nonconforming.



Genicgender – An individual whose identity is affected by the origin of their system, their personal headmate origin, or practices associated with system and/or headmate formation (eg. tulpamancy). All identities under this umbrella are exclusive to systems/headmates of the described origin in individuals with Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar systems. Identities under this umbrella include:

Tulpamancy/Tulpas

- **Tulpagender** – An individual who is affected by being a tulpa in a system.
- **Gendertulp** – An individual who is affected by having a system of only tulpas, having a system that has tulpas within it, or having a system originally formed through tulpamancy.
- **Tulpamagender** – An individual who has been affected due to previously attempting tulpamancy, or is affected/changes when actively practicing tulpamancy.

Parogenic/Parogens

- **Genderparogen** – An individual who is affected by being a parogen (parogenic headmate) in a system.
- **Genderparo** – An individual who is affected by being the body, host, or core of a system of only parogens, a system that has parogens within it, or a system originally formed parogenically.
- **Parogender / Genicgender** – An individual who has been affected due to previously attempting to form a parogen, or is affected/changed when actively attempting to form a parogen.

Quoigenic

- **Genderquo** – An individual who is affected by having a quoigenic system or being a quoigenic headmate. The term is also an umbrella term for other genicgenders for the origins under the quoigenic umbrella such as the ones listed below.
- **Congender** – An individual who is affected by having a congenic system or being a congenic headmate.
- **Gendercrypto** – An individual who is affected by having a cryptogenic system or being a cryptogenic headmate.
- **Praesigender** – An individual who is affected by having a praesigenic system or being a praesigenic headmate.

Multigenic

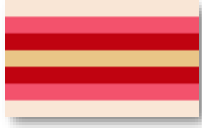
- **Gendermixed / Gendermulti** – An individual who is affected by having a mixed origin/multigenic system or being a mixed origin/multigenic headmate. The term is also an umbrella term for other genicgenders for the origins under the mixed origin/multigenic umbrella as listed below.
- **Isoscegender** – An individual who is affected by having an isoscegenic system or being an isoscegenic headmate.
- **Genderpan** – An individual who is affected by having a pangenic system or being a pangenic headmate.
- **Chaogender** – An individual who is affected by having a chaogenic system or being a chaogenic headmate.

Neurodiversity Origins

- **Genderneuro** – An individual who is affected by having a neurogenic system or being a neurogenic headmate.
- **Neurotraumagender / NTGender** – An individual who is affected by having a neurotraumagenic system or being a neurotraumagenic headmate.
- **Genderpara** – An individual who is affected by having a paragenic system or being a paragenic headmate.
- **Stressgender** – An individual who is affected by having a stressgenic system or being a stressgenic headmate.

Other Origins

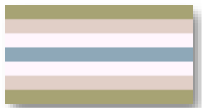
- **Endogender** – An individual who is affected by having an endogenic system or being an endogenic headmate.
- **Gendertrauma** – An individual who is affected by having a traumagenic system or being a traumagenic headmate.



Girlflux / Womanflux – An individual who has an identity that fluctuates between being a girl, a demigirl, genderless, and various degrees of intensity in-between.



Graygender / Greygender / Gray Agender / Grey Agender – An individual has an ambivalence towards their gender or they feels a weak connection to gender in general.



Graypangender / Greypangender – An individual who feels pangender but in a very faint, soft, weak, or blurred way, or in a way that is hard to identify.



Grayvoicegender / Greyvoicegender / Greyvoice – An individual who fluctuates, shifts and/or changes from one gender to another when they are listening to someone speak, but with infrequent changes or less intense changes than an individual who is Voicegender or Audiogender.



Gxrl – An individual whose gender is both female and agender/genderless in some way. They can be Multigender, Agender, or fluctuating between feeling female and agender/genderless.



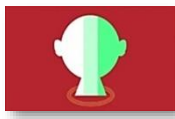
Haludelugender – An individual whose gender changes while experiencing hallucinations or delusions. This can be due to a specific disorder such as schizophrenia, or a symptom of an unknown one. This term is specific to those who experience hallucinations and/or delusions.



Hawaiiine – An individual whose gender identity is related to beaches, blue skies, clear water, Hawaii, pineapples, time, volcanoes, and warmth. Similar terms include the Aecor system and Virmgender.

Headmate – An imaginary friend or an alternate personality in an individual with Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID) or Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. A headmate is a singular entity in a plural system or collective in one body. “Alter” is the clinical term for a person inside a system. “Headmate/sysmate” is a non-clinical alternative.

Hermaphrodite – Obsolete term for intersexual.



Hijra – A culture-specific identity separate from a man, woman, or transgender individual that is found in India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Nepal. Usually Hijras follow orthodox Hinduism but may Muslim or Christian. In most cases, a Hijra is an individual who is assigned male at birth (AMAB) and has a feminine presentation.



Humangender – An individual whose gender identity is not based on masculine or feminine characteristics but on the entire range of human characteristics.



Impulgender / Kindergender – An individual that feels very childish, hyperactive, and/or impulsive. This identity is associated with age regressors however it can be used by anyone.



Intensidysphoric – An individual whose gender feels extremely intense to the point that they feel extremely intense dysphoria when misgendered and extremely intense euphoria when gendered correctly. The intensity of their gender, euphoria, and/or dysphoria may fluctuate constantly.



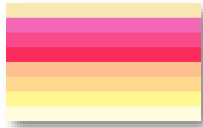
Intensiflux – An individual who feels a very intensity of most kinds of genderflux. They will instantly switch between their intense-feeling gender/s to absolutely nothing/agender.



Intergender – An individual who identifies across or beyond male/female gender ideals. It is a gender identity for some intersex people who identify between or as a mix of the binary genders of man and woman.



Intersex – An individual that has ambiguous sexual characteristics (sexual organs, reproductive organs, and/or chromosome patterns) either present at birth or showing up later in life. Intersex individuals may identify with any sexual orientation or gender identity. It is not proper to use this term as a noun or verb i.e. “Intersexed”. Individuals in the Intersex community often denote assigned sex using the terms CAFAB and CAMAB (Coercively Assigned Female/Male At Birth) surgery to fit them in a mold or male or female is forced on them without their consent.



Intrafeminine / Intra-fem – A trans or non-cis individual who was assigned female at birth (AFAB) and identify fully/partially as any feminine gender or feel that femininity strongly influences their gender.



Intramasculine / Intra-masc – A trans or non-cis individual who were assigned male at birth (AMAB) and identify fully/partially as a masculine gender or feel that masculinity strongly influences their gender.



Ipsogender – An intersex individual identifies as the sex they were assigned at birth. Ipsogender is based on a binary system while intergender is a non-binary gender identity.

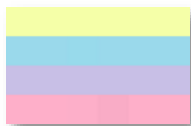


Juxera – An individual whose gender is strongly connected to femininity, but in a different way to how women are connected to femininity. It is feminine aligned or fingender, but is not woman aligned or fiaspec, and has no connection to womanhood.



Kenochoric – An individual with kenopsia which is the eerie atmosphere of a place that has been abandoned. Feelings and/or connections associated with this condition include: liminal spaces, voids, loneliness, nostalgia, distortion, darkness, nonhumanity, fogginess, emptiness, melancholy, genderlessness, gender apathy, distortion, instability, and/or disconnect. Gender identities that are Kenochoric in alignment are known as Kenic genders and are known as KEIN, Kenous, or Kenoine genders. Terms associated with this identity are:

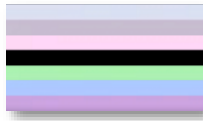
- **Kenomasc / Kenofem** – A Kenochoric individual who is masculine-aligned and feminine-aligned respectively.
- **Kenochorique** – A Kenochoric individual who is completely separate from any part of the gender binary.
- **Kenovoid** – A Kenochoric individual with a gender that is absent, empty, or simply not there.
- **Kenofluid** – An individual who is fluid between Kenochoric genders.
- **Kenovir** – An individual who is male-adjacent, male-aligned, and/or male-identified and centered around the idea of kenopsia.
- **Kenoera** – An individual who is female-adjacent, female-aligned, and/or female-identified and centered around the idea of kenopsia.
- **Kenoavire** – An individual who is male- and female-adjacent, male- and female-aligned, and/or male-and female-identified and centered around the idea of kenopsia.



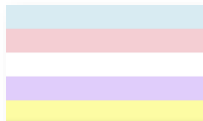
Kingender – An individual whose gender identity is related to their kintype (a non-human identification). This identity is exclusive to individuals who are Otherkin. If an individual is not Otherkin, they cannot be Kingender.



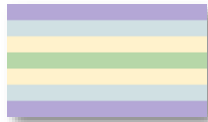
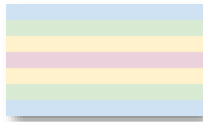
Kindifluid / Kindigender / Kingenderfluid – An individual whose gender is fluid between different Kingenders. They have multiple kintypes and shift between them or they are polymorph or shapeshifterkin. When a Kindifluid being kinshifts their Kingender changes to suit their current Kin. This identity is specific to Otherkin and Therian beings.



Littleagender – An agender individual who finds big labels too confusing or feel a lack of gender that can't be explained. This identity is exclusive to age regressors in their little state.



Littlefluid / Genderlittle – An individual whose gender changes when switching from a maximum age headspace to littlespace. This identity is exclusive to individuals affected by age regression and system age-sliders.



Littlegender – An individual whose identity can only be described by system littles since the experience of being a little in a system is so unique. This identity is specific for systems that have littles and age sliders. This identity can be considered a counterpart to Syskidgender.



Librafluid / Libraflux / Agenderflux – An individual whose gender identity it mostly agender, but has a connection to other genders some of the time.



Librafeminine – An individual whose gender identity is mostly agender, but has a connection to femininity.



Libramasculine – An individual whose gender identity is mostly agender, but has a connection to masculinity.



Libranonbinary – An individual whose gender identity is mostly agender, but has a connection to other genderedness that is neither masculine nor feminine.

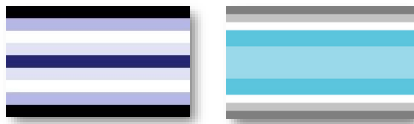


Lunarian – A non-binary individual who is feminine aligned in the Galactian Alignment System. In many cultures around the world, the moon is personified as a woman, or is associated with feminine energy. The masculine equivalent is Solarian. The neutral/unaligned equivalent is Stellarian.

Magigender – An individual whose gender identity is a strong witch feeling. Identities under this umbrella include:



- **Magigirl** – An individual who connects strongly with a being a witch and slightly as a girl. This is similar to Demigirl but more specific.



- **Magiboy** – An individual who connects strongly with being a witch and slightly as a boy. This is similar to Demiboy but more specific.



- **Maginonbinary / Magienby** – An individual who connects strongly with being a witch and slightly as non-binary. This is similar to Deminonbinary but more specific.



- **Magineutrois** – An individual who connects strongly with being a witch and slightly neutrois.
- **Magifluid** – An individual whose identity changes between being a Magigirl, a Magiboy, and Maginonbinary.



Man / Male / Boy / Cisman – An individual whose gender identity of male matches his birth assigned sex of male and usually but not always male sex characteristics, and a masculine gender expression/gender role.



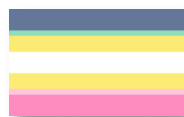
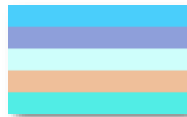
Maverique – A non-binary individual who may at times associate with a masculine, feminine, or neutral identity. However they identify, it is accompanied by a strong conviction about their inner sense of self.

Masculine / Masculinity – A set of behaviors, presentations and roles which are culturally associated with being a man and/or possessing male sex characteristics. Individuals of any gender identity or sexual orientation can be masculine, as masculinity is not designated by biological sex or gender. The concept of masculine is based on socio-cultural settings.

Metagender – An individual who has a tenuous connection to the concept of gender. Meta usually means “after” or “beyond”.



Metrosexual – A heterosexual male who is focused on his personal grooming, wardrobe, and appearance.



Miagender Spectrum / Miaspec – An individual who is on the male viabinary-to-binary spectrum. Their identity may be male, partly male (but not partly fiaspec), male-aligned or adjacent, boyflux, or is similar to or in some way resembles maleness.

Microlabel – A label of gender identity or sexual orientation that falls under or overlaps with, a broader term.



Milkgender – An individual whose gender identity is related to milk from the Cinnamoroll universe. This identity was created for age regressors however anyone can use it. It is similar to Cinnagender but younger, smaller and more playful.



MOGAI / MOGA / IMOGA / MOGMI / MOGII – An acronym for Marginalized Orientations, Gender Alignment, and Intersex. MOGAI is an umbrella term for people who are not cisgender and/or heterosexual.



Mortugender – An individual who has strong ties to/relates to death in some way or that is influenced by Cotard's Syndrome.



Multigender – An individual with multiple gender identities, more than one at a time. This includes identities such as: Bigender, Pangender, Genderfluid, Genderflux, Agender, and Neutrois. They can use whichever pronouns they want.



Muto-Disordered Gender System / Mutodisorder System – A system of identities that change in situations associated with mental and/or physical conditions and disorders, or symptoms of them. An individual who identifies as Muto-disordered has a gender that changes due to something experienced in their conditions/disorders. There are 5 larger umbrella terms within the gender system:

- **Episodegender** – An individual's identity changes while experiencing an outbreak or episode as a result of a mental disorder. This is exclusive to those with mental disorders involving outbreaks/episodes.
- **Haludelugender** – An individual's identity changes while experiencing hallucinations or delusions.
- **Disemotugender** – An individual's identity changes while experiencing an emotion or feeling associated with their disorder(s).
- **Neuromutogender** – An individual's identity changes while experiencing something specific to a disorder that is not covered by the other categories.
- **Physidisogender** – An individual's identity changes while experiencing a physical challenge involving a disorder/condition.

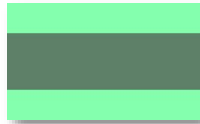


Mutogender – An individual whose gender changes in response to a specific situation. It can include things like one's location, the time of day, the people one is around, etc.

It can be an umbrella term for these identities: Absorgender, Aerogender, Affectugender, Artemgender, Aistralic, Aliquidgender, Agori, and Blustian.



Mutoic – A genderfluid individual who also changes in response to a specific situation.



Mutolic / Mutalic – An individual who has one or more of their headmates attracted to other headmate(s) of a specific gender(s). This is call Alter Loving Alter) (ATLAT) or Headmate Loving Headmate (HLH). This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. Identities under this umbrella include:

Necrogender – An individual whose gender used to exist, but is now dead or nonexistent. This can be due to a variety of reasons, such as trauma or life-altering events. However, there is not always a reason as to why this has occurred.



Necroboy – An individual whose gender used to be male but is now dead or nonexistent.



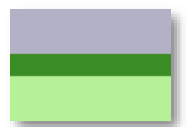
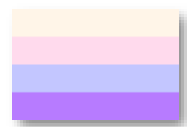
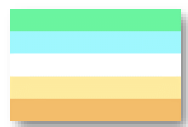
Necrogirl – An individual whose gender used to be female but is not dead or nonexistent.



Neoboy – A non-binary individual who has a connection to masculinity, but in a way that's largely different from how men are connected to masculinity. Their identity is masculine-aligned, neutral-aligned, Mingender, and/or Miaspec.



Neogirl – A non-binary individual who has a connection to femininity, but in a way that's largely different from how women are connected to femininity. Their identity is feminine-aligned, neutral-aligned, Fingender, and/or Fiaspec.



Neopronoun

Gay - A gay man or Vincian who uses neopronouns.



Neptunian / Merjuparian – A non-binary Xenogender individual in the Celestial Gender System that feels their energy is soft, celestial masculine. The feminine equivalent to Neptunian is Venusarian.



Neurogender – Both an identity and an umbrella, this term describes when an individual's gender is linked to their neurotype, mental illness, or neurological conditions.



Neuromutogender – An individual's gender changes while experiencing something specific to a disorder that is not covered by the other categories in the Muto-Disordered Gender System. Examples may include but are not limited to, meltdowns, panic attacks, hyperfixations, and overstimulation. This identity is specific to those with these experiences.



Neutrois – A non-binary individual whose identity is neutral or a null gender but not agender.

Neuter – An entity who is sterile or has no sex or gender identification.



Non-binary / Enby / NB / NBi – An individual whose gender identity does not exclusively fall into the binary gender classification of only man or woman. they may identify with either masculinity or femininity to some degree, to both, or to neither. Synonymous identities under the NB umbrella include: Non-binary Girl/Woman, Non-binary Boy/Man, Demigender, Genderqueer, Intersex, or Transgender.



Non-binary Girl/Woman – A female-identified individual that feels close to a binary female without being that gender fully.



Non-binary Boy/Man – A male-identified individual that feels close to a binary male without being that gender fully.



Non-bxnary – An individual whose gender is both non-binary and agender/genderless in some way. This term can be used interchangeably with Nxutral.



Nonconforming – An individual with any identity that is outside of or beyond the traditional binary identities of male and female.

Nongender – An individual who has no gender identification.



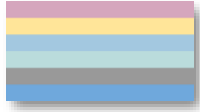
Nxutral – An individual whose gender is both null/neutral and agender/genderless in some way.

Ominogender – An individual whose identity feels ominous yet elegant in its presence.

Outhrine / Outhrine – Any gender quality or identity that does not suit masculinity, femininity, neutrality, or androgyny. It can also be used to describe a unique combination of said qualities.



Pacigender – An individual whose identity is related to pacifiers and childlike objects. These individuals may be age-regressors.



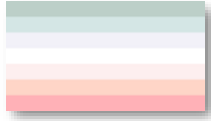
Pangender – An individual that identifies as all genders. The term emphasizes there are more than only two genders. This identity can go beyond the current knowledge of genders identifying infinitely with gender. The pangender label is limited to identities within one's own culture and experience.



Pangenderfae – An individual who identifies as being all genders that are not masculine or male.



Pangenderfaun – An individual who identifies as being all genders that are not feminine or female.



Pangenderslyphen – An individual who identifies as being all Xenogenders, masculine genders, feminine genders, and otherwise uncommon identities other than binary male and female.



Petregender – An individual whose identity is influenced by their experiences with pet regression. This term is exclusively for pet regressors.



Physidisogender – An individual whose gender changes while experiencing a physical challenge involving a disorder/condition. This can include physical tic attacks, flare-ups, physical stimming, and more. This term is specific to individuals with disorders/conditions that involve physical challenges.



Plushinia – An individual whose identity is affected by plushies/stuffies or stuffed animals. This identity is exclusive to Littles, Age-sliders, Pet Regressors, and Age Regressors in plural systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar reasons. Variants identities under this umbrella include:

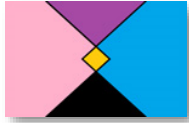

Polygender – An individual that identifies with more than one gender at a time (but not all), typically more than 3.

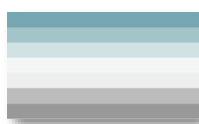
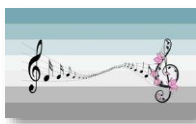


Pomogender – An individual who denies or does not fit any labels for any particular gender. PoMogendered is short for “postmodernly gendered”, which means an individual has a non-orientation. They disregard gender and sexual labels altogether. From the book *PoMoSexuals: Challenging Assumptions about Gender and Sexuality* edited by Carol Queen and Lawrence Schimel.

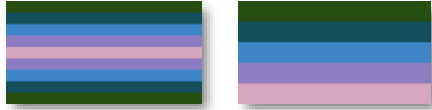
Postgenderist – An individual whose social and political viewpoint supports the elimination of human gender identity and includes the advocacy of assistive reproductive technology.



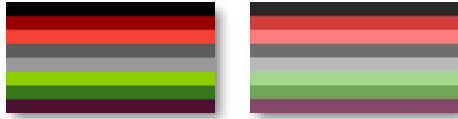
Preseuphorie – An individual whose gender feels more intense, stronger, and more powerful when one is dressed in clothing and presenting in a style that makes one feel euphoric, comfortable, and happy.



Propemusicorum – An individual whose identity shifts or changes when they are listening to someone they are close with play an instrument/make music.



Propevoicgender – An individual whose identity fluctuates, shifts, or changes when they are listening to someone they are close with talk.



Punkcoric – An individual whose identity is related to the punk subculture and aesthetic.



Queer – An individual or community who are not cisgender heterosexual. It is a reclaimed word that should only be used to describe individuals who self-identify as queer.

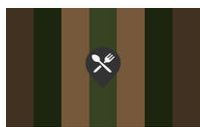


Questioning – An individual who is questioning their current gender identity, role, and/or expression.

Quoigender – An individual who doesn't quite understand their gender or doesn't want to define their gender.



Rencgender – An individual whose gender confuses and infuriates them because of their Borderline Personality Disorder (BPD), causing the individual to impulsively collect labels trying to find one that fits.



The Restaurant System – A gender identity system related to types of restaurants, eateries, or food outlets. Various identities include:

- **Cafegender** – A gender that relates to being in a cafe or coffee shop, coffee, cafe foods, and/or the aesthetics of cafes and coffee shops.
- **Soulfoodgender** – A gender that relates to soul food, soul food restaurants, and/or their homey aesthetics.
- **Finegender** – A gender that relates to fine dining, elegance, formality, modern expensive dishes, and/or fine dining restaurants.

- **Dinergender** – A gender that relates to diners, retro aesthetics, neon signs, jukeboxes, and other features of diners.
- **Pubgender** – A gender that relates to pubs and their features.
- **Bistrogender** – A gender that relates to bistros, casual dining, cozy aesthetics, and other features.
- **Fastfoodgender** – A gender that relates to fast food outlets, drive-thrus, and/or fast food.
- **Bargender** – A gender that relates to bars, barstools, eating at bars, and/or late nights.
- **Familyfoodgender** – A gender that relates to family restaurants, activities for the children, childhood meals, and/or friendly/playful environments.
- **Pizzeriagender** – A gender that relates to pizzerias, pizzas, and/or the smell of pizza cooking.
- **Tearoomgender** – A gender that relates to tearooms, elegant aesthetics, tea, small cakes or biscuits, and other features.



The Scene System – A system of specific gender identities which describe a gender experience that has a complex combination qualities that come together to form a scene. Some identities under this umbrella include:



- **Panscenian** – An individual who identifies as all genders in the Scene System. They may feel all at once or be fluid between them, but they feel a connection to the themes of the entire system. Identities under this umbrella include:
- **Polyscenian / Polyscenifluid** – An individual who identifies with multiple genders of the system but not all of them, They may feel all at once or be fluid between them.
- **Scenianfluid** – An individual who is fluid between genders in the Scene System. They may be fluid through all of them (Panscenifluid), many of them (Polyscenifluid), or just a few (Multiscenifluid).
- **Genderstory** – An individual whose multiple Scenegenders feel like an entire story instead of just individual scenes.
- **Worldscenian** – An individual whose multiple Scenegenders feel like a planet, a world of some kind of a complex concept.

Other subsets of this identity include:

- **Abratramonic** – A gender that is like cuddling or hugging someone during a sunset.
- **Ahiamendian** – A gender that feels like a sunset over a mountain.
- **Akrothalassián** – A gender that is like sitting on the edge of the shore, feeling the waves wash up over you.

- **Albeirapan** – A gender that is like a beautiful, intense sunrise/sunset over a snowy mountain.
- **Apisoleic** – A gender that is like a remote beekeeping farm in a sunflower field with sunshine.
- **Astraitelian** – A gender that is like a pure universe filled with stars and soft grey light.
- **Astranoirian** – A gender that feels like watching the starry sky on a cool summer night.
- **Aquistian** – A gender that feels like a lake on an early morning, with mist hanging over the water, and the lake surface still as glass.

- **Colaiscolaen** – A gender that feels like a quaint, beautiful college campus.
- **Compugender** – A gender related to computing hardware, and affiliated computer peripherals.
- **Constellahian** – A gender that is like constellations against a sunset.
- **Deasilvaean** – A gender that is like an unending path that winds forever through the forest.
- **Densilvaeic** – A gender that feels like an immensely dense forest, thick with foliage and very little light.
- **Dieremissa** – A gender that feels like a brown cat resting in a wheatfield, basking in the sun.
- **Duesmarian** – A gender that feels like learning about the Greek god, Poseidon.
- **Eiralean** – A gender that is like an ancient, dusty, mysterious library.
- **Eirireinean** – A gender that is like a sun rising over the entire world bringing it to life.
- **Eldricysun** – A gender that is like a comforting scene between a parent and their child.
- **Emielean** – A gender that feels like an ancient, decrepit, crumbling castle.
- **Faraharian** – A gender that is like an autumn forest at sunset.
- **Farahacoziic** – A subset that is specifically like a cozy, warm autumn forest at sunset, with animals and cozy undertones and warm colors.
- **Faiaminnian** – A gender that feels like a dusty attic filled with childhood memories.
- **Falusian** – A gender that feels like a rustic ranch in the beautiful countryside.
- **Fantavilleian** – A gender that feels like a ghost town.
- **Faronottean** – A gender that is like streetlights lining a street at night.
- **Ferocinanic** – A gender that feels suspended in the void with a feeling of importance and arrogance with shadowy figures who emanate authority and sinister power.

- **Feumyrnian** – A gender that is like a great fire burning down everything which taunts it.
- **Fogueiraeen** – A gender that is like a campfire under a starry sky.
- **Folioumian** – A gender that is like an autumn leaf floating to the ground.
- **Foscouvian** – A gender that is like cuddling up in a blanket in the dark and watching a movie.
- **Fraceraean** – A gender that feels like a set of ornate, beautifully fragile pottery.
- **Fyrcoisean** – A gender that feels like a lighthouse overlooking the sea at night or during a storm.
- **Galacassean** – A gender that feels like a shattered mirror.
- **Galamorycti** – A gender that is like being with a loved one under a starry night sky.
- **Galochendian** – A gender that is like a starry sky over a mountain lake.

- **Prozanzian** – A gender that is like falling off a cliff but landing in a safe area, where you feel warm and accepted.

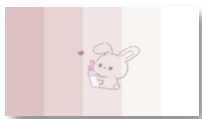

Singularian – A non-binary individual in the Galactian Alignment System who rejects all forms of alignment. It is similar to being agender. Singularian cannot be combined with any other gender identity. Other proposed terms for it include Voidian, Voidarian, and Voidic.

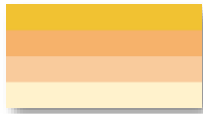


Soft-littlegender – An individual whose gender is affected by a soft presentation such dressing up in soft style of binkis, dresses etc. This term is exclusive to

Solarian – A non-binary individual who is masculine-aligned in the Galactian Alignment System. In many cultures around the world, the sun is personified as a man, or is associated with masculine energy. The feminine equivalent is Lunarian. The neutral/unaligned equivalent is Stellarian.



Solgender – An individual whose identity is connected to the sun.



Spacialian – A non-binary individual who is xenine-aligned in the Galactian Alignment System. Their gender identity is unrelated to typical human gender alignments.



Spikegender – An individual whose gender is mostly undefinable but they occasionally experience sudden and intense spikes of a specific gender identity that last a relatively short time.

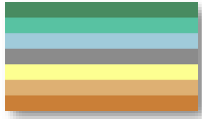


Stargender – An individual that has the gender of a star or an other-worldly/non-human identity.



Stellarian / Stellar Non-binary – A non-binary individual who is abinary/unaligned or neutral-aligned in the Galactian alignment system.

Stud – An individual who identifies as a black masculine lesbian. It is sometimes used to refer to masculine Latinx lesbians. Stud is similar to butch but stud is exclusively for black lesbians.



Syselfic – An individual whose identity is directly connected to being an elf, or feel as though their gender is affected by their elf-self. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Sysgodic – An individual whose identity is related to their headmate being a God/Deity/Celestial being or they feel as though their gender is affected by their God-self. headmate in a system. This identity is exclusive to systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Syskidgender – An individual whose gender can only be described by syskids (a headmate who is a young age) because of the uniqueness of the identity. This identity is exclusive to syskids and age sliders in a system due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions. This term may also be considered a counterpart to Littlegender.



Sysrobotic – An individual whose identity is related to being a robot/animatronic/AI headmate in a system or feel affected by their robotic-self. This identity is exclusive to syskids and age sliders in a system due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Systemfluid – An individual whose identity changes depending on who is fronting. This gender is intended for multiple and median systems alike. This is an exclusive identity to plural systems due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Tattoogender – An individual whose gender is connected to, affected by, or otherwise related to tattoos, receiving tattoos, etc.



Tattooic – An individual whose gender feels like a tattoo; a gender which feels like giving a tattoo; a gender which feels like designing a tattoo; a gender which feels like receiving a tattoo.



Tootix – An individual whose gender is influenced by their connection to tattoos, tattoo aesthetics, and/or a love for tattoos, or a gender that can only be described by or through tattoos due to one being neurodivergent.



They/Them Gay – A gay man or non-binary individual who uses they/them pronouns.



They/Them Lesbian – A lesbian woman who uses they/them pronouns.

Third Gender – An individual whose gender role is outside of the gender binary of male and female. This identity is typically used for cultures that recognize more than 2 genders such as: Hijra in India, Two-Spirit in Native American cultures, and Fa'afafine in Samoa.



Tomboy – A girl who exhibits characteristics or behaviors considered typical of a boy.



Tophatgender – An individual whose identity is related to top hats.

Trans* – Trans with an asterisk is a relatively new label that represents an umbrella under which any variation that is not cisgender is represented. Identities that may be included are: agender, androgynous, bigender, gender fluid, genderqueer, intergender, multigender, nongender, transgender, transsexual, transwoman, transman, transvestite, third gender, and two spirit. There is some disagreement about whether the following identities are under the trans* umbrella: crossdresser, drag performer, drag queen, drag king, intersex, and transvestite fetishists. *Trans* is Latin for “on the other side” or “across”.



Trans Ally – Cis individuals that support the Trans* community and activities.



Transandrogynous – A transgender individual who identifies as trans* as well as exhibits neither or both masculine and feminine characteristics.



Transfeminine / Transfem / Transfemme – A transgender individual, typically assigned male at birth, whose identity is predominantly feminine. However, not all individuals who are transfeminine identify as a woman. Any feminine-identifying non-binary individual, demigirl, girlflux, genderfae, or other feminine-aligned individual is considered to be transfeminine.

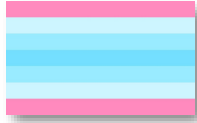


Transgender / Trans – An individual whose gender identity is different than the birth assigned sex. They may or may not have taken steps to change their assigned gender at birth (AGAB) which is usually based on their external genitalia. However, an individual’s gender identity does not always match their assigned gender. Transgender people can be binary or non-binary. Transgender individuals may or may not transition socially and/or physically from their assigned gender to their actual gender identity. It is not proper to use this term as a noun or verb i.e. “transgendered”.

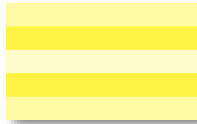
Transgenderist – An individual living or preferring to live in a gender role opposite their birth assigned sex. Usually refers to a transsexual who does not intend to have genital reassignment surgery or hormone therapy.



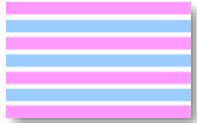
Transman / FTM / F2M – A transgender individual who was assigned female at birth (AFAB) but whose gender identity is more male than female. They often identify as masculine of center (more masculine than feminine).



Transmasculine / Transmasc – A transgender individual, typically assigned female at birth, who has a gender identity that is predominantly masculine. However, not all transmasculine individuals identify as male. Any masculine-identifying non-binary individual, demiboy, boyflux, genderfaun, or other masculine-aligned individual is considered transmasculine.



Transneutral – A transgender individual, typically assigned a binary gender at birth (ABGB), who has an identity that is predominantly neutral or androgynous.



Transsexual – An individual that emotionally and psychologically feels that they do not belong to their assigned gender at birth (AGAB). These individuals usually take steps to change their birth assigned sex through Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT) and Genital Reassignment Surgeries (GRS). Sex Reassignment Surgery (SRS) and Gender Reassignment Surgery (GRS) are now considered obsolete terms. The correct terms are Gender Confirmation Surgery (GCS), Genital Reconstruction Surgery (GRS), or Genital Reassignment Surgery (GRS).

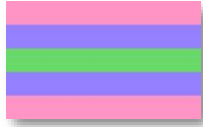
Trans System / Transitional System / Transgender System – An individual whose plural system has gotten or desires to get a gender-related surgery for the body, as a collective or when all headmates within a system are a gender that is the opposite of the body's sex. This identity is exclusive to individuals within a system due to Dissociative Identity Disorder (DID), Other Specified Dissociative Disorder (OSDD), or similar conditions.



Transwoman / MTF / M2F – A transgender individual who was assigned male at birth but whose gender identity is more female than male. They often identify as feminine of center (more feminine than masculine).



Traumahoarder / Traumahoardergender / Traumahoardersexual / Traumahoarderromantic – An individual who hoard trauma related identities such as genderbruised, caedsexual, malneromantic, etc. because they don't feel that one label fits their experience quite right. Since trauma is so complex and impacts such a large amount of a victim's life, some individuals may not be able to distinguish the separation between their gender and/or orientation. This identity is exclusive to trauma survivors.



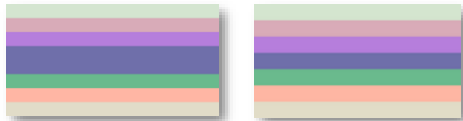
Trigender – A non-binary individual who experiences 3 distinct genders.



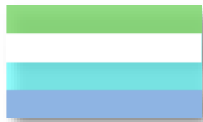
Twink – Boyish-looking, young gay man, typically aged 18–22, that may have some feminine characteristics.



Two Spirit – An individual that has both a masculine and feminine spirit and fulfills mixed gender roles as well as a spiritual role in Native American, Canadian First Nations, and Aboriginal groups. Two-Spirit is also an ancient teaching among Indigenous people and should be used exclusively by these cultural groups.



Uingender – An individual whose gender is unknown, unnamed, undecided, unsure, undefined, unidentified, unquantifiable, unexplainable, or undetermined in nature. Identities under this umbrella include: Aeregender, Confugender, Pomogender, Quoigender, and Spikegender.



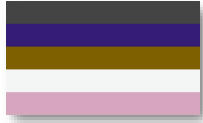
Unlabeled / No Label / Non-labeled – An individual who does not wish to label their identity with more specific terms. People can have many personal reasons for wanting to forego labeling themselves, such as feeling that current labels do not fit how they feel, or just not wanting to label themselves for the time being.



Vexigender – An individual's gender is connected to the Minecraft mob, vex. An individual who is vexigender can feel dull, torn, aggressive, mystical, greyscale, or have any other qualities resembling the mob.



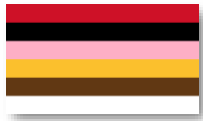
Vocagender – An individual experiences their gender(s) only when they are talking about them out loud.



Voicegender – An individual whose identity shifts, changes, or fluctuates in intensity when they are listening to someone speak.



Voidgender / Gendervoid – An individual whose identity is absent, a blank space or void where a gender might otherwise be.



Waria – An Indonesian individual who was assigned male at birth (AMAB) but lives as a woman. They may identify also identify as transgender and/or non-binary. This identity is unique to the Indonesian culture.



Woman / Female / Girl / Ciswoman – An individual whose gender identity of woman matches her birth assigned sex of female and usually but not always female sex characteristics, and a feminine gender expression/gender role.



Xenogender – An individual whose gender identity is other, i.e. non-binary, non-trans, and non-cis. Their identity embraces other methods of gender categorization such as relating to animals, plants, or other non-human categories. *Xeno* means alien.

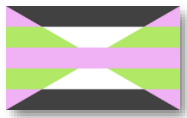
Xenic / Xeno-aligned – An individual whose identity does not fit the human binary of gender alignments. They would feel more aligned with animals, plants, things, and/or concepts.



Xenopan – An individual who identifies as all xenogenders within a specific category or theme. The themes or categories would be up to the individual, however they should not identify as genders that are exclusive to cultures outside of their own. Xenopan is an umbrella term that include some of these identities:

- **Pangenderspace** – Includes all genders related to space.
- **Pangendersun** – Includes all genders related to the sun/sunshine/sunlight.
- **Pangendercute** – Includes all genders related to cute/soft things and aesthetics.
- **Pangenderdark** – Includes all genders related to darkness.

- **Pangenderneuro** – Includes all genders related to an individual's neurodivergence/mental illness.
- **Pangenderart** – Includes all genders related to a form of creative art.
- **Pangenderfauna** – Includes all genders related to animals, types of animals or a specific animal that can be specified if one desires.
- **Pangastrogender** – Includes all genders related to flavors/food/drink, that can be specified if one desires.



Xirl – An individual who identifies as a non-binary girl, non-binary girl-adjacent, or in some way is related to femininity.
